Nothing succeeds like success.




Kabir continues to be an inspiration to all such students of IPSCR who aspire zealously to work for success in various disciplines and make their mark in the national and international arena.

We are proud of our students are perfect examples of such changemakers who are stewards of the change to work towards a cleaner and greener environment.







- Playfully creative games to promote imagination and inventiveness in DaF lessons.


